## **7. CEWF continues Participation in Upper Trent Watershed Management Partnership (UTWMP)**

- **UTWMP has functioned primarily as an information exchange group with 6 municipal members and Haliburton County members, and 3 CEWF representatives.**
- **UTWMP is exploring the possible formation of a Watershed Council for the Upper Trent Basin.**
  - **There has been extensive liaison with other water and environmental agencies in the watershed**
  - **Discussions are at an early stage.**
